



In 1958, Grace Upjohn, widow of Harold Upjohn, the vice president and general manager of the Upjohn Company until his death in 1928, established the Harold and Grace Upjohn Foundation for “religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational purposes within the United States of America.” As defined in its articles of incorporation, the Foundation was formed “to assist specific charitable projects . . . which cannot be financed through the regular budget of eligible organizations and institutions maintained for one or more of the purposes hereinafter set forth and to aid and assist (such) . . . organizations and institutions which, because their work is not publicized or generally known . . . do not receive adequate financial support (from other sources) . . .

- to promote scientific research along lines for the alleviation of human suffering;
- to care for the sick, aged and helpless whose private resources are inadequate;
- to conduct research for and otherwise assist in the improvement of living, moral and working conditions;
- to promote the spread of education and to provide scholarships for deserving young men and women;
- to promote and aid in the mental, moral, intellectual and physical improvement, assistance and relief of the poor, indigent or deserving inhabitants of the United States of America, regardless of race color or creed.

In keeping with the wishes expressed in these articles, the Foundation makes grants primarily for specific projects. Although grants are made from time to time to help organizations meet unexpected operating deficits, the Foundation does not normally assist in recurrent financing of operating expenses or annual fund drives.

Grants may be made only to organizations or institutions which are exempt from taxation under the Internal Revenue Code.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURES & GUIDELINES

Application and completion instructions can be found at the Foundation's website, [haroldandgraceupjohnfoundation.org](http://haroldandgraceupjohnfoundation.org). The application is available for download throughout the year. The application is available for completion online during the designated acceptance periods.

A completed grant application form must be signed by an authorized officer of the requesting organization.

Each request must be accompanied by a copy of the organization's current U. S. Treasury Department Tax Exemption Section 501(c)(3) letter and its classification under Section 509(a) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Grant requests are submitted to the Trustees for consideration. All applicants within the greater Kalamazoo area will be notified in writing of action taken by the Trustees shortly after each Trustee meeting.

Acceptance Period: The Foundation will accept grant applications only during two periods each year as follows:

<u>Time Period</u>	<u>Deadline Date</u>	<u>Trustees Meeting</u>
1. Month of March	April 1	Spring
2. Month of August	September 1	Fall

Applications must be dated within the acceptance period so information presented will be current.

Trustee meetings are not scheduled on specific dates, but Trustees typically meet in the spring and fall, depending on grant requests received and funds available for distribution. Tentative meeting dates can be obtained by contacting the secretary.

Grant making priorities of the Foundation are general purpose and not limited to any specific area of interest, although Trustees may designate a portion of income to certain categories.

While there is no geographic limitation, practice and availability of funds has restricted most grants to the greater Kalamazoo area.
